Carol Jegou is the Chairman CEO of All Green Recycling, Inc and the focus of our April 2017 Executive Spotlight. Carol was born in New Jersey and attended West Virginia University and studied Psychology. She has lived in North Carolina for 3 years and set up All Green Recycling Inc. in Charlotte due to growing environment and technology presence. When asked how she got to this point, she responded "Six years ago I was consulting to Fortune 500 women. My husband decided he wanted to start a new business in the fast growing Electronic Recycling business. We both had a vision to create technology for this sector that would revolutionize the industry. We are now a "nationally certified woman owned business" with an IP patent pending process to extract precious metals from circuit boards. Our headquarters are located in Charlotte, NC." Her goal includes becoming a recognized leader in the industry and she is well on her way!

She still has a strong work-life balance and expresses her biggest accomplishment is being married for 44 years and raising a beautiful accomplished daughter, who lives in SC. "To add to that I have friendships that have lasted a lifetime, I am very blessed."



Even Carol was surprised to end up on this road. "From a business standpoint I think if you were to ask me 6.5 years ago what are you going to do with your life, this would not have been on the list. To that point I am amazed at what we have accomplished at All Green and how we are changing the industry. I have been led on this path for a reason."

But there are challenges. Carol states "Finding good employees with strong work ethics. We want them to have a sense of commitment to move forward as the company progresses and make All Green Recycling Inc. a solid career path. We also reward hard work with bonuses in stock for a very definitive sense of ownership."

All Green is putting corporate culture at the top of the list and believes in caring for their workers and the environment. They have started a non-profit within All Green - AGR Foundation that trains and employs individuals with barriers to employment in the e-waste industry. They have had many people in the program and it is very rewarding to

see the value these individuals have and how they contribute to the community. They also started a program here in Charlotte to refurbish computers and get them to families who did not have any means or ability to have a computer. It is a way of assisting with the digital divide and giving back to the community.

What is the next big project Carol is working on? "We are in the planning stage to expand our IP process to the next level. Very exciting!"

What does Carol do for professional development? Joining like-minded organizations to not only meet potential business partners but learn new business lines and cultures. NCTA is a perfect example. I am also on the Wipe Out Waste Ambassador committee and the Green Works Council/Charlotte Chamber
